Re: *Recycling Economic Information Study Survey and Statement of Confidentiality*

Dear Recycling Business Owner:

**The Illinois Recycling Association (IRA)**, a not-for-profit organization, was formed in 1980 as the Illinois Association of Recycling Centers, and changed its name to IRA in 1990. It currently has 250 members consisting of municipal, county, and state recycling coordinators, businesses, haulers and processors, not-for-profit organizations, consultants, and manufacturers of recycled-content products. IRA's mission is to encourage the responsible use of resources by promoting waste reduction, re-use, and recycling. IRA's goals are to:

- Provide educational leadership through forums, programs and materials for the exchange of information and ideas;
- Promote waste reduction, re-use and recycling through public education; and,
- Promote market development that encourages sound recycling initiatives.

Through a grant from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, IRA has contracted with DSM Environmental Services, Inc. (DSM) of Windsor, Vermont to undertake an update of the Recycling Economic Information Study. The purpose of the study is to estimate the value of the recycling and reuse industry in Illinois and to use the data to educate both elected officials and entrepreneurs on the size and economic impact of the recycling and reuse industries. The ultimate goal is to document that recycling is a vital industry and important contributor to Illinois' economy.

We hope you will be willing to participate in the survey conducted by DSM. DSM will hold confidential any information and data provided to us. DSM is prepared to sign a confidentiality agreement, if requested by you. All data provided to DSM, including the number of employees, gross payroll, and estimated annual receipts will be aggregated with data from other establishments surveyed to develop state-wide estimates by industry type.
