RE: Norwich Historic Preservation Commission – Membership

On October 14, 2009, the Selectboard adopted an ordinance to for Establishment of Historic Preservation Commission. The ordinance became effective December 14, 2009. On April 14, 2010, William Aldrich, Roger Blake, Peter brink, and Nancy Hoggson were appointed to the Historic Preservation Commission by the Selectboard. No terms were specified at the time of appointment or in the ordinance. The ordinance specifies “.... not less than three nor more than seven members appointed by the Selectboard.”

Based on a consensus of the membership at a regular meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission on March 30, 2011, the Commission is requesting that the Selectboard adopt the following:

- Three year terms for Historic Preservation Commission members starting May 1, 2011.
- Set the expiration of terms by different years to allow for an orderly change of members.
- Set the expiration of the terms of existing members to Aldrich – 2012, Blake – 2013, Hoggson and Brink – 2014.
- Advertise for three additional members with terms ending in 2012, 2013, 2014.
